

REGISTRATION PROCESS OF THE 85TH ANNIVERSARY AND NATIONAL LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE

Those who are interested to participate in the webinars that are exclusive for SCA members will be requested to fill up an Online Registration Form that would allow the participants to receive the link of all webinars and activities. We will be posting the Registration Form in the SCA community private page for easier access. In line with this, there will be a separate Online Registration Form with the intent of gathering data of the participants who would represent their diocese during the leadership conference and business meetings.

GUIDELINES FOR CONDUCTING SERVICE PROGRAMS

As a tradition in celebrating our National Leadership Conference, we conduct action-planning and community immersions after having fruitful discussions with our resource speakers. Due to the pandemic, we have opted to conduct community outreach programs in our respective units and communities. In light of this, we highly encourage our Student Catholic Action leaders to implement Service Programs and share them with us as part of our national gathering.

Here are the details needed in submitting your service programs:

- The diocese/unit should fill up all the necessary details in the given template.
- Service Programs that were conducted from January 2021 until present time can still be acceptable.
- Dioceses/units who plan to conduct Service Programs must implement it within the third week of March up until the second week of May.
- Don't forget to include the documentation of your service programs.

QUALIFICATIONS AS PARTICIPANT FOR THE 13TH NATIONAL LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE / CONFERENCE PROPER

Conference Proper is a part of the national gathering, the National Leadership Conference is a Business Meeting in SCA. It is a two-day conference wherein different student representatives from various arch/dioceses will gather to reflect and propose actions based on the agenda set by the National Coordinating Council for the future endeavor of the movement. With this, we are providing certain qualifications for those who will be participating in the Conference.

Each school/unit is given only 3 slots (depends on SCA setup in the diocese) following gender balance:

- 1 SCA Adviser/Animator/Chaplain
- 1 High School Leader (preferably SCA President or next in rank and has at least one school year left to study in the same school)
- 1 College Leader (preferably SCA President or next in rank and has at least one school year left to study in the same school)

*If unit has no college department or has only a college department, the school may send 2 high school leaders or 2 college leaders

*It is very important to send participants with enough knowledge of SCA because the conference will study and plan for proposals, decisions, and direction of the movement in the next three years. This does not apply to invited dioceses which don't have SCA groups yet.
